LUMAKRAS™ (Sotorasib) Now Approved for the Treatment of Adult Patients with KRAS G12C-mutated Locally Advanced or Metastatic Non-Small Cell Lung Cancer

ABOUT METASTATIC NON-SMALL CELL LUNG CANCER

According to the National Cancer Institute's (NCI's) Surveillance, Epidemiology, and End Results (SEER) program, 235,760 patients will be diagnosed with lung cancer in 2021, with a corresponding 131,880 deaths. When considering all stages and histologic subtypes of the disease, the five-year overall survival (OS) of lung cancer is 21.7%. Patients with Stage IV metastatic disease have a five-year OS of only 6.3%. Unfortunately, 56% of lung cancer patients have metastatic disease upon initial diagnosis. Up to 85% of lung cancer cases are classified as NSCLC.¹ Approximately 13% of NSCLC patients have KRAS G12C mutations.²

LUMAKRAS is manufactured by Amgen, a global biopharmaceutical company dedicated to the discovery, development, and commercialization of novel therapies for the treatment of cancer. The FDA's approval of LUMAKRAS comes as a result of a 124 patient subset of the Phase I/II CodeBreak 100 clinical trial (NCT03600883) which demonstrated that previously treated patients with metastatic KRAS G12C-mutant NSCLC experienced a 36% objective response rate (ORR) after LUMAKRAS administration.³ For full prescribing information, visit lumakras.com.
